#### **Part I: Scope of Consultancy Services**

The Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank or the Bank), on behalf of the Government of India (GOI), has approved financing of a project out of a Line of Credit extended to the Government of Republic of Sierra Leone for Land and Infrastructure Development Including Hydraulics, Water Management System (Irrigation) and provision of Tractors in Sierra Leone. A part of the LOC shall be utilized for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) and for appointment of Project Management Consultant (PMC), for which Exim Bank now seeks applications for prequalification from eligible Indian Consultancy firms. Refer Part II ITA 4 for eligibility provisions.

#### A] Background of the Project

Agriculture is the mainstay of the Sierra Leone economy, contributing about 60.70% to GDP and employing over 80% of the workforce. Given the importance of agriculture for the economy of Sierra Leone, agricultural development has become a major priority for the government. In the past, Government's strategy in agriculture has been driven by focusing on intensification, diversification and commercialization of smallholder agriculture (through improving value-addition and access to market). In 2021, Government of Sierra Leone (GO-SLE) prioritizes its food security drive in line with the global Agenda for Sustainable Development 2030 and as adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in 2015. The GO-SLE therefore acknowledges climate-smart agriculture and natural resource management which are very important in achieving sustainable economic development.

The Ministry of Agriculture continues to strengthen its policies towards sustainable and diversified production of food, including crops and animals, on a scale sufficient enough to feed the growing population as well as providing gainful employment while maintaining the natural resource base. The Priority actions of the ministry will focus on (i) increasing investment in agriculture (ii) increasing food crop production (iii) increasing cash crop production (iv) improving irrigation and water management (v) improving land management and (vi) improving governance and research.

GO-SLE launched on July 19, 2018, the transformation of the rice value chain programme which aims at fostering productive business linkages between smallholder farmers and large-scale agribusiness firms in the private sector which will result in creating jobs through developing local value addition industries along the entire rice value chain. The focus of the agriculture development would be for the food security of the country and also to develop commercial crops for trade and exports.

The major challenge to the sector is access to land. The land policy is currently going through a revision process, including laws related to land acquisition. Furthermore, Sierra Leone has not been able to harness its rich water resources

and arable land to support its rice production which is its main staple food. The water resources need to be harnessed to provide the most vital input of irrigation to increase yield in existing cultivated lands and bring new areas under cultivation.

GO-SLE to achieve rice self-sufficiency suggests the urgent need to increase rice production and productivity which can be achieved through increasing the area under cultivation as well as rice yield per unit area. GO-SLE intends to undertake the development of 51,300 hectares land in Tomabum (Bonthe District) which will improve the economic scenario in the region and is expected to change the living conditions for the people in and around the region. The project is proposed to construct Dam / Bund / canals and field channel system for irrigation including farm mechanization along the rivers viz. the Sewa and Wanjei which will help stop the flooding in the area and will be used for irrigation. The rice and other crops can be cultivated in rotation in a year and expected to enhance fertility of the area.

With the availability of the water throughout the year and use of the right type of the fertilizers and pesticides, the production of rice and other nutritious crops can be increased at least twice. The provision of properly designed canals and field channel system to ensure uniform distribution of water which will avoid drainage overdosing of water and the salinity of soil. The people will get better nutritious food and vegetables which will increase their health status. By going for cash crops, per capita income will improve which will enhance the overall living standard of the entire region. The overall purpose of the project is to achieve rice self-sufficiency, reduce the import of rice and reduce poverty among those engaged in the rice value chain and other crops in Sierra Leone.

#### **LOCATION AND TOPOGRAPHY**

The Torma Bum-Gbondapi flood plain shall be the piece of land under consideration. It lies within the Riverine Grassland ecology in the Southwest of the country and has an area of about 130,000 hectares. Out of which, the project aims at the development of 51,300 hectares land in Tomabum (Bonthe District). In terms of drainage, the area lies within the Sewa River basin, which has an area of about 6,870 km². The smaller river, Waanje, lies within the Sewa River basin.






Figure 1: Map of Sierra Leone depicting the main drainage system, including the Sewa and Waanje Rivers (red).

The project area belongs to the physical region of the Coastal Plains, which consists of beach ridges, alluvial plains and coastal terraces in a predominantly low relief. The deposition of alluvium along the Sewa River has given rise to extensive grassland plains which, partly due to the low relief, are flooded excessively during the rainy season, during which time the rivers (Sewa and Waanje) overflow their banks. Fringing the coastal plains along their seaward side is a zone of beach ridges that are most extensive in the Turner's Peninsula area. Here, the ridges can extend to 20 km in width. The ridges lie parallel to the coast, causing Sewa and Waanje Rivers to deflect and the Waanje River to flow parallel along the coast for 50 km before joining the Sewa River, from where the two rivers continue down to join the sea (UNDP-FAO, 1979) near Bonthe Island. About 70% of the area is seasonally flooded, depth of which varies with the topography. Along the higher levees close to the two rivers, water collects to depths of about 50 cm. Then in the lowest parts of the plains (e.g., near the confluence of Sewa and Waanje), flooding can occur to depths of 2 m at peak rain period.




Figure 2: A map of the Torma Bum-Gbondapi Flood Management Project area depicting the background topography, main lakes and rivers and settlements in the region.

The two rivers meander considerably as they run parallel to the coast, but with no immediate direct outlet to the Atlantic Ocean (Figures 1 and 2). This is due largely to the Turner's Peninsula, which lies perpendicular to Sewa River and thereby prevent direct discharge into the ocean. Waanje River has part of its source from Male River at Gbondapi. It is a complex network of stretches of the main water course, flanked on both sides by finger-like inlet/outlets and one of which starts/ends at Lake Mapi. Figure 2 shows a map of the Torma Bum-Gbondapi area, depicting the general topography, settlements, the two main rivers (Sewa and Waanje Rivers) and some of the freshwater lakes.

The topographical and hydrological conditions described above lead to excessive flooding in the area, especially at the lower reaches of the two rivers. About 6–7 times of flooding occur in the region during the period from August to September every year. The flood depth can be 5–7 m above the lowest level in the dry season. The flood waters annually bring in and deposit a lot of silt on the flood plain, enriching the soils and supporting good rice cultivation. However, the lack of flood management means that field operations such as mechanized ploughing and

harrowing have to be done in February to March, well before the floods. Traditionally, farmers have adopted methods such as planting rice varieties that can cope with the flood waters or delay planting by planting after the floods recess. This latter practice was observed at one village during the visit in early February 2020, where Nerica-L19 was planted in December 2019 on residual soil moisture.

#### **OBJECTIVE**

The major objectives of the project are to prepare a detailed project report for land and infrastructure development including hydraulics, water management system and provision of tractors in coordination with Ministry of Agriculture, the Republic of Sierra Leone. More specific to the objectives are the detailed tasks below:

- (i) undertaking relevant studies in among other areas
  - Soil types, composition/constituents
  - Water bodies and their pathways, including flood depths and river discharge
  - Land: the expanse of cultivable land, identifying those submerged in the peak of the rainy season, improve or conserve soil fertility and social land issues
  - Climate and farming patterns
  - Impact on Farmers currently living off the land
  - A prefatory Environmental, Social, and Health Impact Assessment (ESHIA) and a mitigation plan
- (ii) Costing the implementation of identified activities;
- (iii) Study about the catchment area (Arial coverage),
- (iv) Types of potential agricultural products,
- (v) Clear construction plan, details of designs and drawings,
- (vi) Mechanization of Agriculture,
- (vii) Usage of Hybrid Seeds for Agriculture etc.

#### **B]** Scope of work

#### i) Lot - I: Preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR)

Preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) for Land and Infrastructure Development Including Hydraulics, Water Management system (Irrigation) and provision of Tractors in Sierra Leone in coordination with Project Authority.

The scope for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) for Lot – I, shall broadly include but not limited to the following:

- ➤ A topographic survey of the lands proposed to be brought under the Irrigation System;
- Suggestions including designs options of various irrigation systems and the ways the fields are to be laid out, prepared and leveled for equitable distribution of irrigation water;

- > Testing of soil and water be carried out to ascertain the types of fertilizers required and to determine quality of water for irrigation;
- A determination of availability/adequacy of water for sustainable irrigation and quality of soil suitable for rice production, etc.;
- ➤ A determination of requisite equipment and harvesting tools based on the cropping seasons to include: harrows, cultivators/ploughs, scrappers for leveling of land, land clearing equipment, equipment for making dowels and channels, sowing machinery and harvesting equipment, etc. need to be supplemented in great measures;
- ➤ A determination of the other crops, needed to provide richness in nutrition value and palate in Tormabum, and Gbondapi areas depending upon the field conditions;
- Requirement and availability of skilled and unskilled human resources in the region, as may be required during construction phase of the contract;
- Commitment from various departments of the Government of Sierra Leone for implementation of the project, such as tax exoneration, allotment of land, environmental clearances, security to the Indian personnel, clearance of goods from the port authorities and transportation to the site, etc., as an information to the prospective bidders;
- ➤ A report stating cost benefit analysis for various technologies/options available for the completion of the project;
- Availability of the major project components from Indian entities, along with the names of established and reputed Indian suppliers conforming to the requirement of 75% Indian Content. Attainability of the minimum Indian content of 75% value of the contract of work and equipment;
- ➤ The DPR consultant, while arriving at detailed cost estimates and breakup including detailed design, should also mention about feasible transport routes for material from India and associated costs of work and equipment;
- Requirements in connection with EIA (Environment Impact Analysis) studies and applicable regulations, and environmental clearance/approvals; and
- The DPR consultant would need to evaluate the technical and financial sustainability plan of the proposed project and the capability of the host Government to ensure smooth maintenance of the project post implementation;

#### <u>Lot - II Project Management Consultant (PMC) services:</u>

Project Management Consultant services for Land and Infrastructure Development Including Hydraulics, Water Management system (Irrigation) and provision of Tractors in Sierra Leone. The PMC must closely work with the Local government officials.

The Project Management Consultant (PMC) services shall broadly include but not limited to the following:

#### Phase - I

Tender Engineering, including Preparation of Technical Specifications, Tender documents of work and equipment;

- Assistance in Tender evaluation and recommendation of award of Procurement and Construction contract of work and equipment;
- > Review of designs and equipment list;
- Technical assistance in finalization of Bills of Quantities and the budget of work and equipment (BOQ);

#### Phase - II

- > Synchronization of shipments from India by contractor in tandem with physical progress and site preparedness;
- Inspection of materials at manufacturer's works before dispatch to site;
- > Supervision of civil works, and monitoring of implementation of the project;
- Certification of work progress and invoices including the requirement of 75% Indian Content in each contract;
- > Submission of monthly, periodic Status report to project authority, Exim Bank, Indian Mission in Sierra Leone and Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India;
- Evaluation of operations and maintenance;
- > Flagging of foreseen delays in the project on timely basis.
- To issue Completion Certificate at various stages and Final Completion of the of the project; and
- Any other specific requirements specified by the Borrower in tender documents.

#### C1 Contract execution period

**Lot – I:** Detailed Project Report (DPR) is expected to be prepared and submitted within a period of six (6) months from the date of award of the contract.

**Lot – II:** Project Management Consultants' (PMC) scope of work will commence after DPR is approved. The PMC service will commence from preparation of tender documents until the end of the Defects Liability Period (DLP). The total duration of the contract is expected to be 24 months (6 Months for Phase I and 18 months for Phase II) and 12 months defect liability period.

#### There shall be separate contracts for DPR and PMC.

#### **D]** Project Authority

The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, Sierra Leone is the Project Authority for the project.

#### **E]** Application

The Applicant may apply for a single lot, or both the lots.

#### F] **GOI Guidelines**

As per the GOI guidelines, goods, works and services for minimum 75% of the value of the contracts covered under these Lines of Credit, must be sourced from India. Applicants are advised to refer to the GOI guidelines mentioned above which are also available at:

#### **Part II. Instructions to Applicants**

#### A. General

#### 1. Background

The Export-Import Bank of India (hereinafter called 1.1 "the Bank"), on behalf of the Government of India (GOI), extends from time-to-time, concessional credit facilities (hereinafter called "Lines of Credit") under the Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme (IDEAS) to overseas governments their nominated or agencies (hereinafter called "Borrower or Employer"), for financing projects to be executed by Indian entities. Payment by the Bank to the Indian exporters will be made only at the request of the Borrower and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the credit (or financing) agreement.

### 2. Scope of Prequalification

2.1 With reference to the Invitation for Prequalification (IFP) indicated in Part III, Data Sheet (**DS**), this Application Document ("Application Document") is being issued by the Bank to prospective applicants ("Applicants") interested in submitting applications ("Applications") for prequalification as per the scope described in Part I, Scope of Consultancy Services and subject to the provisions of this Application Document.

### 3. Ethics and Integrity

- 3.1 The Bank requires Applicants to participate in this prequalification process with the highest standards of ethics and integrity. It is strictly forbidden to the parties involved in the prequalification process, by themselves or by a third party, to offer, ask or accept for itself or for a third party, financial or non-financial advantage or even direct or indirect promise or any other acts<sup>1</sup>, as offsets for prequalification or bidding or contract award and execution as applicable, if susceptible of being qualified as criminal unlawful acts in accordance with national laws of any party involved.
- 3.2 In pursuance of ITA 3.1 above, Applicants shall permit the Bank to inspect all accounts, records and other documents relating to the submission of the Application, bid submission (in case prequalified), and contract performance (in the case of award), and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Bank.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> These acts shall include, but not limited to, corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, collusive practice, coercive practice, obstructive practice, and conflict of interest.

- 3.3 If, in accordance with the administrative procedures of the Bank, it is demonstrated that an Applicant in this prequalification process, or during the subsequent bidding for the contract(s) has violated the provisions stated in ITA 3.1 above, the Bank, inter alia,
  - a. shall reject any Application for prequalification or proposal to award a contract in connection with the subsequent procurement process, as applicable; and/or
  - b. may declare an Applicant, temporarily or permanently, ineligible to be awarded future contracts under Bank funding.

#### 4. Eligibility of Applicants

- 4.1 This prequalification exercise is open to only Indian Applicants in accordance with the provisions of ITA 4.4. Any form of association by the Applicant with ineligible entities either during this prequalification process or subsequent bidding process may be liable for rejection.
- 4.2 For the purpose of applying the eligibility criteria listed in this article 4, "Applicant" would include the single entity or in case of a joint venture ("JV"), each member of the JV, involved or intended to be involved with this prequalification process (as mentioned in Form A.1.2 Applicant's/ JV Member's Information Form), for any part of the prospective contract(s) including related services.
- 4.3 An Applicant may be a single entity or a combination of entities in the form of a JV either existing or with the intent to enter into a JV supported by a letter of intent or JV Agreement listing out the names of all the JV members. In the case of a JV, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the contract(s) in accordance with the respective contract terms. The JV shall be represented by an authorized representative who shall have the authority from all members of the JV to conduct all business for and on behalf of the JV during the prequalification process. The limit on the number of members in a JV would be as specified in the **DS**.
- 4.4 This prequalification exercise is open to only Indian Applicants. An Applicant shall be deemed to be Indian if the Applicant is constituted, incorporated or registered, and operates in accordance with the provisions of the laws of India, as evidenced by its articles of incorporation and its registration documents, as the case may be.
- 4.5 An Applicant that has been blacklisted/ debarred/ sanctioned by any Multilateral Development Agency (MDA) or any authority in India or the borrowing

country in accordance with extant rules and procedures, shall be ineligible to participate in the prequalification/ bidding process as applicable, during such period of time as the sanctioning authority shall have determined. In case the Applicant is blacklisted/ debarred/sanctioned post the prequalification process (i.e. including, during bidding process and/or Project implementation phase), the Applicant shall immediately inform Exim Bank of such blacklisting/ debarment/sanction and reasons thereof. This may lead to cancellation of pregualification / contract.

- 4.6 The list of debarred firms and individuals by certain leading MDAs is available as specified in the **DS**. This may not be an exhaustive list of debarred entities but those which are made available centrally on the respective MDA's website. Additionally, there could be lists of debarred entities issued by various government departments/ procuring entities/ corporations and maintained offline.
- 4.7 An Applicant shall be ineligible to be pregualified if (a) it is currently under default on any loan to any Bank/ Financial Institution (FI) and its account has been classified as Non-Performing Asset (NPA) as per Central Repository of Information on Large Credits (CRILC) database; and (b) its promoters/ directors appear in Negative List, RBI Wilful Defaulter List (Suit filed as well as non-suit filed), Credit Information Bureau India Ltd. (CIBIL) Defaulter List and/or any other negative list of central and/or state government agencies, updated from time-to-time. On being included in any of the above lists post the pregualification process (i.e. including during bidding process and/or Project implementation phase), the Applicant shall immediately inform Exim Bank on the inclusion and reasons thereof. This may lead to cancellation of prequalification / contract.
- 4.8 An Applicant shall furnish such evidence of eligibility satisfactory to the Bank, as the Bank shall reasonably request.

- 5.2 Unless obtained directly from the Bank, the Bank shall not be responsible for the completeness of the document, responses to requests for clarification, or Addenda to the Application Document in accordance with ITA 7. In case of any discrepancies, documents issued directly by the Bank shall prevail.
- 5.3 An Applicant is expected to study all instructions, and forms in the Application Document and to furnish with its Application all information or documentation as is required by the Application Document.

- 6.1 A prospective Applicant requiring any clarification of the Application Document shall contact the Bank in writing at the Bank's address indicated in the **DS**.
